Welcome to the David Lloyd Golf Club

We make no apologies for the publication of this outline of the rules and etiquette expected at the David Lloyd Golf Club, as we feel it is our duty to ensure that the standards of dress and behaviour in the Club and on the course are kept as high as possible.

Making yourself aware of the rules will avoid any embarrassment to yourself or officials and members of the club.

For us, the ownership and maintenance of our course and club is a job of great pride and pleasure. Naturally we wish every golfer who plays here to enjoy the course and facilities to the full.

Tee Reservations

The David Lloyd golf course operates on a pay and play basis. Start times can be booked through the golf reception (0208 7831698) up to 7 days in advance (14 days for David Lloyd Golf Members). You must check in to the pro shop at least 20 minutes your allotted time, and be ready to play at the 1st Tee 10 minutes prior to your tee time.

Please Note: No refunds or credits will be made for Late Arrivals, No Shows, Poor Weather or Slow Play.

- David Lloyd Golf Members reserve the right to book up to 14 days in advance.
- All other players are able to book up to 7 days in advance

Dress Code

Smart casual dress is requested at all times.

- Golf Shoes or Trainers only
- No Denim
- No track or shell suits
- All shirts must have a collar
- No shorts unless tailored

Etiquette, Course Care & Player Consideration

For the enjoyment of all, players are politely requested to observe the following common sense rules:

- No Club or bag sharing
- Avoid Slow play. Give other players in front and behind you the consideration they deserve. In order to keep the flow of play continuous please call players through if you lose more than one hole.
- Replace divots, repair pitch marks and rake bunkers
- No Trolleys on the tees or greens.
- Player must register and pay their green fee at the Golf Reception BEFORE play. If approached by a course marshal players must show a validated green fee ticket.
- We reserve the right to request any visitor not complying with our rules to leave the course.
